

The Diptera described by Martín L. ACZÉL

[Die von Martin L. ACZÉL beschriebenen Dipteren]

Abstract	A list of the Diptera described by the Hungarian dipterist Dr Martín Ladislao ACZÉL is presented. ACZÉL was an expert on the Neotropical fauna of acalyptates and published more than 70 papers on the taxonomy of the Diptera, proposing a total of 162 dipteran names of various taxonomic ranks, from division to subspecies.

Zusammenfassung	Eine Aufstellung der von dem ungarischen Dipterologen Dr. Martín Ladislao ACZÉL beschriebenen Dipteren wird vorgelegt. ACZÉL war ein Experte für neotropische Acalyptratae, publizierte mehr als 70 Arbeiten zur Taxonomie der Dipteren und schlug auf verschiedenen taxonomischen Ebenen (von der Division bis zur Unterart) insgesamt 162 Dipteren-Namen vor.

Introduction

Dr Martín Ladislao ACZÉL (Fig. 1), was born as ACZÉL Márton László on 8 June 1906 in Budapest. In 1925, he began his studies of Natural Sciences at the Royal Hungarian University of Sciences “Pázmány Péter”. He obtained his doctorate on 12 May 1933 with a botanical thesis on the anatomy of the leguminous subgenera *Cercidothrix* and *Calycocystis* (ACZÉL 1933).

Between the years 1931 and 1934, while still a student, he became adjunct professor at the University Institute of Systematic Botany and Phytogeography, as assistant to Professor János Tuzson (FERENC 1959).

In 1934 he was employed by the Royal Hungarian Institute for Plant Protection as an applied entomologist. ACZÉL worked with
